- Presenters must be registered before August 17, 2024.

# **Scoring Applications**

Applications are scored based on: A complete and accurate application – **INCOMPLETE SUBMISSIONS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED AND REMOVED FROM REVIEW** 

- Quality of submitted presentation
- Speaker experience and qualifications related to the topic
- Compelling presentation "story" that will engage the audience
- Adherence to the theme, "Breakthrough to Excellence, Beyond All Limits"

# **Presentation Mission Area and Educational Track**

Each presentation must be categorized by both the FEMA Mission Area and the Educational Track it best represents:

FEMA Mission Areas:

- **Prevention**: Prevent, avoid, or stop an imminent, threatened, or actual act of terrorism.
- **Protection**: Protect our citizens, residents, visitors, and assets against the greatest threats and hazards in a manner that allows our interests, aspirations, and way of life to thrive.
- **Mitigation**: Reduce the loss of life and property by lessening the impact of future disasters.
- **Response**: Respond quickly to save lives, protect property and the environment, and meet basic human needs in the aftermath of a catastrophic incident.
- **Recovery**: Recover through a focus on the timely restoration, strengthening and revitalization of infrastructure, housing, and a sustainable economy, as well as the health, social, cultural, historic, and environmental fabric of communities affected by a catastrophic incident.

Educational Tracks:

- **Preparedness and Planning**: The Preparedness and Planning track is designed to equip attendees with the knowledge and skills necessary to plan, organize, and coordinate effective response efforts before a disaster or emergency occurs.
- **Response and Operations**: The Response and Operations track focuses on the practical aspects of managing and executing emergency responses.
- **Recovery**: The Recovery track delves into the post-disaster phase, emphasizing the processes and strategies for rebuilding and restoring affected communities.
- Administration and Leadership: The Administration and Leadership track is tailored for professionals in managerial and leadership roles within emergency management.
- **Training and Exercises**: The Training and Exercises track is dedicated to enhancing the knowledge and capabilities of emergency responders and managers through simulations, drills, and training programs.

# After Your Proposal is Selected

The selection process for presenters and alternates will be completed by **May 22, 2024**, and all accepted presenters must register for the conference before **August 14, 2024**. Failure to register by this date will result in the presenter being excluded from the program, and an alternate presenter will be selected.

Upon notification of their acceptance, presenters are advised to make travel and accommodation arrangements. Presenters are responsible for all associated costs, including accommodation, travel, and meals. KEMA does not provide an honorarium, and all presentations must be provided "pro bono."

Selected presenters (**up to 2 per topic**) will receive a complimentary Conference registration. A "conference themed" PowerPoint (PPT) template will be provided to presenters for their presentations, which they MUST use. Exceptions apply to specific government and non-profit organizations, and eligibility should be discussed with the Conference Chair.

Presentations must not be used for direct promotion of a speaker's products or services, as they are intended to be non-commercial in nature. KEMA will provide a PC-compatible computer, projector, and screen. If presenters require any additional equipment, such as speakers or easel boards, they must provide it themselves.
