Scoring Applications

Applications are scored based on: A complete and accurate application – **INCOMPLETE SUBMISSIONS** WILL BE DISQUALIFIED AND REMOVED FROM REVIEW

- Quality of submitted presentation
- Speaker experience and qualifications related to the topic
- Compelling presentation "story" that will engage the audience
- Adherence to the theme, "Building Resilient Communities, Adapting to a Changing Landscape"

The application requires submission of:

- Primary Contact (Name, Organization, Title, E-Mail, and Phone)
- Speaker (Name, Organization, Title, E-Mail, Phone, and Biography)
- Presentation (Title, Objectives, FEMA Mission Area, Description)

After Your Proposal is Selected

The selection process for presenters and alternates will be completed by **May 5, 2025**, and all accepted presenters must register for the conference before **August 11, 2025**. Failure to register by this date will result in the presenter being excluded from the program, and an alternate presenter will be selected.

Upon notification of their acceptance, presenters are advised to make travel and accommodation arrangements. Presenters are responsible for all associated costs, including accommodation, travel, and meals. KEMA does not provide an honorarium, and all presentations are to be provided "pro bono."

Selected presenters (up to 2 per topic) will receive a 50% discounted Conference registration.

NOTE: If presenters are attending solely to deliver their presentation, a complimentary one-day registration will be provided for up to two speakers per session. This registration includes access to all breakout sessions and conference breaks on the day of the presentation. However, it does not include meals or admission to any special events.

Presentations must not be used for direct promotion of a speaker's products or services, as they are intended to be non-commercial in nature. The Conference will provide a PC-compatible computer, projector, and screen. If presenters require any additional equipment, such as audio speakers or easel boards, they must be provided by the presenter(s).
